

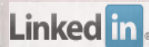
Dear Camp Family,

Important Information, please read carefully. For more details, please refer to the Parent Camper Handbook available for download at www.ondessonk.com

Please ensure your camper's On-line Health Information is completed at least 2 weeks prior to your session. Health forms are available on your camper's Campwise Account. The Camp Health Center has licensed medical professionals throughout the camp week. Please contact the Camping Services Director if your camper has special dietary needs, unusual medications, or a medical or accessibility need that would affect their time at camp. Camp Ondessonk works with parents to create the best possible experience for each camper. Please call us to determine if appropriate accommodations can be made for your child.



Arrival Day Check-in is from 1:00pm to 3:30pm. Please DO NOT bring your pets. Lunch is available for purchase at Tommy's Cafe near the swimming area. Burgers, Hot Dogs, and more are available.



Any camper that must arrive after 3:30pm is required to contact the Camp Ondessonk Office to make appropriate arrangements.



Check Out will be from 9:30am to 10:30am on Saturday. Mini Camp check out is from 8:00am to 9:30am on Wednesday. Check your camper out with their Unit Leader. A parent reception will be held in the Camp Ondessonk Chapel at 9:00am Saturday. Adults picking up a camper MUST be listed as an authorized adult on the camper's registration form and must present driver's license.



Early Departures must be scheduled during one of the following time blocks: 9:00am to 10:30am, 1:00pm to 3:00pm, or 7:00pm to 8:30pm. There will be no early departures on Saturdays.



CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR SESSION for a refund.

Medical cancellations will be made, minus a \$25.00 processing fee, with documentation from child's physician. Non-medical cancellations made more than 4 weeks prior to camper's arrival will be refunded the full amount minus the \$100.00 non-refundable deposit. No refunds will be given for cancellations with less than 4 weeks notice.



Your balance is due **FOUR WEEKS** prior to your camper's date of arrival. Payments may be made via check, money order, Discover, MasterCard, or VISA. A \$100 deposit is required at the time of registration to hold your camper's spot.



Please, **NO FOOD OR DRINK** in Units. We have adopted a zero tolerance policy for pest control. For more information on Camp Ondessonk's food policy, please refer to the Parent Camper Handbook available to download at www.ondessonk.com.



Luggage: Rubbermaid/Sterilite type bins and trunks checked in at Luggage Haul are **NOT TO EXCEED** the following dimensions: 32 inch X 20 inch X 17 inch. Luggage will be searched upon arrival to check for food or contraband. More detailed information can be found in the Parent Camper Hand- book.



Trashcans of **ANY SIZE** will not be permitted to stay in units (living areas). Trashcans will not be delivered to the units by our Luggage Haulers.



Camp Ondessonk offers Bus Service to Camp Ondessonk from Chicago, Springfield, St. Louis area, and points in between. More information can be found in the Parent Camper Handbook. Bus Cargo Space is limited! No Trashcan or Rubbermaid-type luggage containers will be permitted on the bus. Please be courteous of other campers and respect this rule.



Camper Layover Weekend: Campers that choose to attend multiple sessions back-to-back may register for a \$50 layover session on the Saturday between weeks. Layover sessions **CANNOT** be used as an early check-in or late check-out.

Camper Behavior Agreement: All campers are expected to uphold this behavior agreement. At Camp Ondessonk we agree to: 1)Take care of others 2) Take Care of Ourselves and 3)Take care of camp.
