Monsignor Fournie Scholarship Request *Policies and Procedures*

1. A maximum of \$669 of tuition assistance will be awarded per camper. A sliding scale is used to determine the amount of award based on adjusted gross income and household size.
2. Supporting financial documentation includes a copy of federal or state income taxes (first 2 pages) or qualifications for one of the following: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Medicaid. Documentation must also provide proof of guardianship.
3. **Please submit a complete application packet. Applications submitted without supporting financial documentation will not be accepted.**
4. Scholarships are awarded off of the "Rate A" tuition, the actual cost of participation. Please see summer camp brochure or our website for complete pricing information.
5. With the exception of multi-camper and multi-session discounts, scholarship awards cannot be combined with any other discounts or other scholarships.
6. Scholarship applicants are not required to pre-register or pay a deposit in order to determine eligibility. If an applicant qualifies for partial tuition assistance, a registration form and deposit must be submitted before scholarship funding is applied.
7. A Monsignor Fournie Scholarship Request application form (one for each child) must be completed and submitted by email, fax or mail for consideration.
