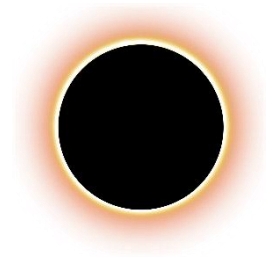

Designated Viewing Locations

- Stable area and all arenas
- Telescope viewing field near the Stables and St. Noel (North Pasture)
- Area directly outside and to the South of the Dining Hall
- Main area of Camp, including the parking lot or assigned lodging units

OFF-LIMITS Viewing Locations

- Closed Activity Areas (swimming area, boating, archery, etc.)
- Any pasture except the designated viewing field (North Pasture)
- Any areas off the entrance/Camp Road (these are private properties)
- Mogan's Field, Kane Lake and Durbin's Barn. These areas are reserved for use by school groups only
