PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

Teambuilding: A unique approach to teambuilding and strengthening a group’s communication and cooperation skills, this experience will challenge students with a series of properly sequenced, physical and mental challenges. As the group grows together, they develop problem-solving skills, connect as peers, and form deeper bonds with each other. These programs are great for developing leadership skills, improving group dynamics, or a fun day of activities.

Environmental Education: Environmental education teaches students about the natural world and how ecosystems work. It is an excellent supplement to their traditional classroom curriculum. These experiences often change students’ perceptions, values, and behaviors regarding the natural world. Many of these programs are aligned with Next Generation Science Standards.
