



Monsignor Fournie Scholarship Request

Policies and Procedures

1. We are faithful to the premise that families applying for scholarship funding are in need of tuition assistance. Please help us honor the wishes of our donors with honorable participation.
2. Scholarship applicants will receive a minimum of \$200 in tuition assistance for Traditional, Mini Camp Explorers and Adventure camps or \$100 for Mini Camp and up to 100% of tuition assistance based upon financial need.
3. In order to receive more than the minimum scholarship award, financial documentation must accompany the application. Supporting financial documentation includes a copy of federal or state income taxes (first 2 pages) or qualifications for one of the following: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Medicaid. Documentation must also provide proof of guardianship.
4. **Please submit complete application packets. Failure to furnish supporting financial documentation will automatically result in an award of the minimum tuition assistance.**
5. Scholarships are awarded off of the "Rate A" tuition, the actual cost of participation. Please see summer camp brochure or our website for complete pricing information.
6. With the exception of multi-camper and multi-session discounts, scholarship awards cannot be combined with any other discounts or other scholarships.
7. Scholarship applicants are not required to pre-register or pay a deposit in order to determine eligibility. If an applicant qualifies for partial tuition assistance, a registration form and deposit must be submitted before scholarship funding is applied.
8. A Monsignor Fournie Scholarship Request application form (one for each child) must be completed and submitted by mail, email or fax for consideration. Include supporting financial documentation for consideration of more funding.

13. Award notification: Camp Ondessonk will contact the parent/legal guardian of each scholarship applicant within 30 days of application submission.
14. Respectfully, your child's application will not be considered unless stated Monsignor Fournie Scholarship request procedures are followed.
